Lager & Pilsner

Red Centre Devil Lager -330ml Bottle - Earth Sanctuary, AUS  - ABV: 4.3% IBU: 20

Our only locally styled beer, RCD is a tribute to Central Australia's native 'Thorny Devil' lizard. It boasts a smooth mouth feel with a refreshing and fruity burst of flavour from the infusion of Quandong, (desert peaches).

The Duel Lager 330ml Bottle - Stockade Brewing Company, AUS  - ABV: 4.7% IBU: 30

Brewed from Oz Pilsner malt and German Dextrin malt, this lager is refreshing in flavour, clean & crisp, with an interesting hop combination that adds subtle floral and lightly spiced flavours with rich tropical fruit and citrus aromas.

Barossa Valley Pilsner 330ml Can - Barossa Valley Brewing, AUS  - ABV: 4.9% IBU: 27

A dry, crisp and refreshing lager with a hint of malt character that comes from only using German malts and hops.

Dancing Bear Lager 330ml Cans - Magic Rock Brewing, GBR  - ABV: 5.5% IBU: ~30

Lager, Munich and Cara malts create the pale colour and classic backbone, while a concoction of Germany's finest Strisselspalt, Herrsbrucker and Hallertau hops deliver a refined bitterness and characteristic herbal hit.

Heyzues Mexican Lager 355ml Cans - Melvin Brewing, USA  - ABV: 5.2% IBU: ~30

Halfway between awesome and fantastic, but with the quality you expect from the great Cerveceria de Melvin. Super simple with an ABV that you can session on all day.

La Bassa Lager 330ml Bottle - Brew Fist, ITA  - ABV: 5.2% IBU: 30

A red-hopped American Lager. Fresh and drinkable, with clean notes ending in a fruity note and resinous bitterness.

Pure Pilsner 330ml Cans - Vocation Brewery, GBR  - ABV: 4.5% IBU: ~25

Never pasteurised, so naturally hazy; pilsner malt, European hops and time result in a clean, crisp and sophisticated beer.

Golden, Blonde & Pale Ale

Bee Sting Golden Ale 330ml Can - Barossa Valley Brewing, AUS  - ABV: 4.7% IBU:17

This crisp brew uses a touch of local Barossa honey and delicate hops to leave your tongue as excited as a freshly disturbed hive. This award-winning ale is light on its toes and big in pleasurable flavour.

Honey Dew Organic Golden Ale 500ml Bottle - Fuller's Brewery, GBR  - ABV: 5.0% IBU: ~25

A light golden beer with a zesty edge and a hint of honey sweetness, Organic Honey Dew is a naturally palatable brew that finds popularity among lager drinkers as well as ale fans.

Ernie Golden Ale 330ml Can - Blackmans Brewery, AUS  - ABV: 5.0% IBU: ~28

Made using all Australian ingredients, ella and cascade hops & pale malt. Light in body with fruity aroma and medium bitterness, Ernie is a golden all rounder.

Experimental 3 Hop Pale Ale 330ml Bottle - Buxton Brewery, GBR  - ABV: 5.2% IBU: ~35

A rare and limited release; this beer is a triple treat of Rakau, Motueka & Pacifica hops, packed into one delicious pale ale.

La Chouffe Blonde Ale 330ml Bottle - Brasserie d'Achouffe, BEL  - ABV: 8.0% IBU: 20

La Chouffe is an unfiltered blonde beer with beautiful fruit on the palate, finishing clean and crisp.

It is pleasantly fruity, spiced with coriander, and with a light hop taste.

Mirror Pond Pale Ale 355ml Bottle - Deschutes Brewery, USA  - ABV: 5.0% IBU: 40

Cascade hops and more Cascade hops give this tawny coloured ale delicious hop-forward aroma and flavour.

Pale malt allows the hops to linger, not overpower.

Pale Ale 375ml Can - Colonial Brewing Company, AUS  - ABV: 4.4% IBU: ~40

A classic golden pale ale showcasing tropical Australian and American hops, fine aromatics and gentle bitterness.

Pale Ale 375ml Bottle – Coopers Brewery, AUS  - ABV: 4.5% IBU: 24

With its fruity character, and robust flavour, Coopers Pale is naturally fermented in the "Burton-upon-Trent" style; a secondary fermentation that creates the trademark sediment that gives 'Pale' its fine cloudy appearance.

Pale Ale 330ml Bottle – Quiet Deeds, AUS  - ABV: 4.6% IBU: 26

A combination of is used to create a light sweetness that is balanced with hop flavours of grapefruit, peach, rockmelon and pineapple. It finishes with a lingering bitterness and notes of citrus.

Pride & Joy American Pale Ale 330ml Can – Vocation Brewery, GBR  - ABV: 5.3% IBU: ~40

Robust hop flavours are layered over a balanced malty backbone. Initially soft to the palate, Pride & Joy builds to a generous, but clean bitterness.

Flavours and aromas of mango, citrus, earthy pine, tropical fruit & blueberry.

South Pacific Dream Pale Ale 375ml Can – Nomad Brewing Co, AUS  - ABV: 4.1% IBU: ~40

A pale ale bursting with fruity hop aromas thanks to the addition of US and Aus hops. Packing a massive tropical fruit aroma punch with a smooth, refreshing finish.

Summer Hop Ale 375ml Can – Young Henrys, AUS  - ABV: 6.0% IBU: 50

Bursting with aroma, this beer boasts a well-rounded hop character of Pine, Rock melon, stone fruit and citrus. A solid bitterness is balanced by the gentle sweetness of Munich Malt and malted wheat while still achieving a seasonably dry finish.

Terminal Pale Ale 330ml Bottle – Brew Fist, ITA  - ABV: 3.7% IBU: 30

Classic Pale ale with the Brew Fist touch, showing the low alcohol session beers can deliver a big flavour profile.

The Sesh Golden Ale 330ml Bottle – Stockade Brewing Company, AUS  - ABV: 4.1% IBU: 30

Dry hopping is key here, creating a beer that's full of pine and citrus aromas. The body is built on some biscuity and caramel malts which give way to a tropical fruit characters, a slightly dry finish and sharp, resinous bitterness.

XPA & IPA

Hop Heaven Easy IPA 330ml Can - Barossa Valley Brewing, AUS  - ABV: 4.8% IBU: 41

This award-winning IPA is crafted to be flavoursome and effortlessly drinkable. Crisp American hops and smooth malt create a bold brew with a powerful spicy nose.

Mosaic Promise IPA 355ml Bottle - Founders Brewing Company, USA  - ABV: 5.5% IBU: 50

This beer showcases two unique ingredients: Mosaic hops and Golden Promise malt. The versatility of the hop's pleasing aroma and flavour characteristics and the traditional barley's depth of flavour comprise this clean, rich, golden beer.

Australian IPA 375ml Can - Colonial Brewing Company, AUS  - ABV: 6.5% IBU: 56

Australian hops deliver tropical fruit and subtle pine notes, alongside locally grown malt to cut through the bitterness. It's a big, bold beauty.

Digital IPA 330ml Can - Yeastie Boys, Wellington, NZL  - ABV: 5.7% IBU: 57

A classic kiwi IPA with a backbone of rich golden clean malt, citrus and tropical hop, and a bold bitterness.

Expatriate IPA 355ml Can - Three Weavers Brewing, USA  - ABU: 6.9% IBU: ~50

A bright, tropical, fruit-forward West Coast IPA. Brewed with Maris Otter and two-row barley, a touch of English crystal malt, and loaded new age American hops,

- \$10.5 -

Trolltunga Farmhouse IPA 330ml Bottle - Buxton Brewery, GBR  - ABU: 6.3% IBU: ~35

Trolltunga is a jutting rock in Norway, hanging 700 metres over lake Ringedalsvatnet.

This beer was brewed to celebrate friendship and a love of wild places. It's sour, fresh and zesty.

Scorpion Bowl Tropical IPA 650ml Bottle - Stone Brewing Co., USA  - ABU: 7.5% IBU: 76

No fruit was harmed in the making of this beer. Instead, they took floral and citrus notes from Mosaic, Loral and Mandarin Bavaria hops to dish up a mouth-watering fruit punch to the palate.

All Day IPA 355ml Bottle – Founders Brewing Company, USA  - ABU: 4.7% IBU: 42
An all-day IPA naturally brewed with a complex array of malts, grains and hops. Balanced for optimal aromatic and a clean finish.

Hop Devil IPA 354ml Bottle – Victory Brewing Company, USA  - ABU: 6.7% IBU: 50
Bold, spicy and menacingly delicious; this American hopped India Pale Ale offers an aromatic punch and then follows through with a lasting, full-bodied finish provided by quality German malts.

Baby Faced Assassin IPA 330ml Can – Roosters Brewery, GBR  - ABU: 6.1% IBU: ~50
Brewed with 100% Citra hops that create aromas of mango, apricot, grapefruit & mandarin orange, along with a lasting, juicy, tropical fruit bitterness, this beer is a deceptively drinkable IPA that shouldn't be taken lightly.

Dirt Wolf Double IPA 355ml Bottle – Victory Brewing Company, USA  - ABU: 8.7% IBU: 65
This dangerously delicious recipe features often subtle, but sometimes assertive signatures of American hop varieties. Look for heavy citrus aromas, fruity flavour, earthy and mildly floral notes of sweet citrus and spice.

Jet Lag IPA 330ml Bottle – Nomad Brewing Company, AUS  - ABU: 6.0% IBU: 65
A tropical style IPA brewed with a combination of pale and ale malts, with the addition of caramel malts and tonnes of American and Aussie hops.

8 Bit IPA 330ml Bottle – Stockade Brewing Company, AUS  - ABU: 6.5% IBU: 60
8 Bit has aggressive aromas and caramel malt flavours. The big bitterness delivered with a high hop flavour is balanced by a sweet malt character.

IPA 330ml Bottle – Quiet Deeds, AUS  - ABU: 5.5% IBU: 43
As a tribute to the beer styles history, this beer has an English malt base, loaded with American and Australian hops.
This combination brings together subtle notes of toffee and caramel with flavours of passionfruit, mango, citrus and pine.

Stout & Porter

Chocolate Coffee Stout 330ml Can – Barossa Valley Brewing, AUS  - ABV: 7.0% IBU: 28

Flavoured with Peruvian cocoa nibs, Barossa roasted coffee, oats and an English Ale yeast for berry fruitiness, this brew is rich, smooth and bursting with flavour.

- \$9.5 -

Vanilla Porter 330ml Bottle – Quiet Deeds, AUS  - ABV: 6.2% IBU: 35

Classic porter flavours of roasted coffee and dark chocolate against a burst of vanilla. Moderate bitterness keeps the subtle sweetness in check, while its thick body and smooth mouth feel make for a big, well balanced beer.

Old Money Oak Aged Stout 330ml Bottle – Stockade Brewing Co., AUS  - ABV: 12.5% IBU: 50

Aged in Lark whiskey barrels for over 2 years, this massive beer has thick, velvety chocolate tones, coupled with raisin & currant notes. It also packs quite a punch, so go easy on 'em.

Speedway Stout 473ml Can – AleSmith Brewing Company, USA  - ABV: 12.0% IBU: 70

Chocolate and roasted malts dominate the flavour, supported by notes of dark fruit, toffee, and caramel, plus a healthy dose of locally-roasted coffee is added to each batch bringing out the beer's dark chocolate character.

The Abyss 2017 Reserve 650ml Bottle – Deschutes Brewery, USA  - ABV: 11.4% IBU: 80

A deep, dark Imperial Stout, The Abyss has almost immeasurable depth and complexity. Hints of molasses, liquorice and other alluring flavours make it something not just to quaff, but to contemplate.

Black Cab Stout 500ml Bottle – Fuller's Brewery, GBR  - ABV: 4.2% IBU: ~60

Brewed with a combination of five different malts, some heavily roasted for a near jet black appearance, this brew boasts luxurious red berry notes, toasty aromas on the nose and culminates in a dry, bitter finish.

- \$17.5 -

London Porter 500ml Bottle – Fuller's Brewery, GBR  - ABV: 5.4% IBU: 33

Rich, dark and complex, at 5.4% ABV the beer has an outstanding depth of flavour. It is brewed from a blend of Brown, Crystal and Chocolate malts for a creamy delivery balanced by traditional Fuggles hops.

Red, White & Brown Ale

Odin's Raven Witbier 330ml Bottle – Stockade Brewing Company, AUS  - ABV: 4.6% IBU: 12

A collaboration with Mjølner restaurant and inspired by a traditional Norse brew, this beer has a slight honey like flavour, coupled with citrus from the addition of orange peel and then juniper berries which add a tart, resinous and piney note.

Chimay Rouge 330ml Bottle – Chimay Brewery, BEL  - ABV: 7.0% IBU: 19

Topped with a creamy head, it gives off a light, fruity apricot aroma. The taste is a balance confirming the fruity nuances noticed in the fragrance. Its taste, which imparts a silky sensation to the tongue, is made refreshing by a light bitterness.

- \$17.5 -

Rapture Red Hop Ale 330ml Can – Magic Rock Brewery, GBR  - ABV: 4.6% IBU: ~40

Uplifting aromas of grapefruit and pine, combine with a pithy orange and pronounced citrus flavour which is balanced against a deeply rich and malty body.

- \$9.5 -

Modus Operandi Sour Red Ale 330ml Bottle – The Wild Beer Co., GBR  - ABV: 7.0% IBU: ~25

A transformation of an old English ale into a beer that is wildly different. A unique, dark, flavourful beer with a smooth, rich, full body and complex fruit flavours of berries, sweet cherries and tannins.

American Wheat Ale 330ml Bottle – Deschutes Brewery, USA  - ABV: 5.0% IBU: 25

This American wheat ale is sessionable year-round. It boasts a subtle hop aroma, thirst quenching citrus finish and a light wheat character.

Oude Tart Flemish Red Ale 750ml Bottle – Bruery Terreux, USA  - ABV: 7.5% IBU: 6

Originating in style from the Flanders region of Belgium, Oude Tart is a Red Ale aged in red wine barrels. It's pleasantly sour with hints of leather, dark fruit and toasty oak.

Dusty Gringo India Brown Ale 440ml Can – Deep Creek Brewery, NZL  - ABV: 6.8% IBU: 60

This brew charges your senses with aromas of a mountain of malt, and a hop kick reminiscent of a steed's hoof. The floral and citrus flavours imparted from the Cascade, Amarillo and Centennial hops, ride on a powerful chocolate malt base.

Infusions & Others

Ginger Beer 330ml Bottle – Matso’s Brewery, AUS  – ABV: 3.5% IBU: N/A

A well-guarded recipe makes up this famous Aussie ginger beer. Perfect for hot afternoons & good company.

Mango IPA 330ml Bottle – Matso’s Brewery, AUS  – ABV: 5.5% IBU: N/A

Based on a classic Belgium Blonde recipe, with 100% mango essence this drink is an easy drinking beer with amazing fruit aromas balanced with sweet dryness.

Wild Goose Chase Saison 330ml Bottle – The Wild Beer Company, GBR  – ABV: 4.5% IBU: ~25

The juicy, tart gooseberries and a culture of wild yeast from local orchards give this a gentle acidity, whilst the generous “dry-hop” enhances the fruitiness.

Violetta 375ml Bottle – Lover Beer, ITA  – ABV: 5.8% IBU: ~30

Lover Beer has created a brew in which the characteristic element is the violet flower, which is also the principal ingredient of a candy produced in the south of Piedmont. The beer has moderate acidity, with delicate fragrance and floral notes.

Golden Monkey Spiced Belgian Tripel 354ml Can – Victory Brewing, USA  – ABV: 9.5% IBU: 25

This warming, flavoured ale is rich in the tradition of Belgian brewing. Imported malts and Belgian yeast are tempered by a sparkling approach and light body. Considerable depth of character with herbal, fruity notes make this one to savour.

Steam Funk Passionfruit Berliner 440ml Can – Deep Creek, NZL  – ABV: 4.5% IBU: 8

This refreshing Berliner Weiss kettle sour is infused with mouth-wateringly tropical, tangy, full of flavour passionfruit. Summer in a glass!

- \$15 -

Cherry Cola Vice 330ml Can – Magic Rock, GBR  – ABV: 5.8% IBU: ~5

Featuring a medley of no less than 20 different ingredients to create a unique beverage with that most recognisable of flavours; cherry cola.

Lucky Jack Grapefruit 330ml Can – Lervig Aktiebryggeri, NOR  - ABV: 4.7% IBU: ~40

The addition of grapefruit peels and pink grapefruit juice to this pale ale has created a beer with a slightly pink hue, more acidity and a lot more fruity freshness!

Hop Splicer Grapefruit XPA 330ml Bottle – Stockade Brewing Co., AUS  - ABV: 4.4% IBU: 31

They've spliced the best of an ultra-sessionable pale ale with grapefruit undertones allowing the zesty flavours to slice through every sip.

Freshie Salt and Pepper Gose 375ml Can – Nomad Brewing Co., AUS  - ABV: 4.5% IBU: 15

Based on the obscure German 'Gose' style, this beer is made with sea water and Tasmanian pepper berry, holding firm flavour while delivering a crisp, refreshing finish.

Sleeping Lemons Lemon Gose 330ml Bottle – The Wild Beer Co., GBR  - ABV: 6.0% IBU: 10

This beer comes in at 6%, lending a bigger, maltier body. The fuller mouthfeel and warming alcohol bring decadent flavours of lemon meringue to the character, while the acidity is more rounded and reminiscent of lemon curd.

Mexicano Chilli & Lime Gose 330ml Can – Magic Rock Brewing, GBR  - ABV: 5.8% IBU: ~12

This brew boasts a sturdy 5.8% ABV, and takes its flavour profile and composition from the michelada cocktail, with great results. It pours a rich red and packs a killer taste.

Gluten Free Organic Premium 330ml Bottle – Schnitzer Brau, GER  - ABV: 5.0% IBU: ~18

This beer uses ingredients which are exclusively naturally gluten-free, and the best millet malt from organic farming.

As no other beers are brewed on the system, Schnitzerbräu really is gluten-free.

Alcohol Free Wheat Beer 330ml Bottle – Erdinger, GER  - ABV: 0.5% IBU: ~10

A premium alcohol-free beer which is free of chemical additives and brewed in strict accordance with the Bavarian Purity Law of 1516 - using just water, malt, hops and yeast.

It has a crisp, earthy aroma of hops.

Ciders

Bertie Apple Cider 375ml Can – Colonial Brewing Company, AUS  - ABV: 4.6%

The cider uses only Victorian apples, which are hand-picked and cold pressed to create a crisp, delicious apple cider that's small on sugar but big on taste.

Wild Berry Cider 330ml Bottle – Rekorderlig, SWE  - ABV: 4.0%

Rekorderlig Wild Berries Cider has the nose of fresh, juicy wild country berries with the subtle undertones of the pear base combine wondrously in this semi-sweet cider to produce a slightly drier finish on the palate.

Apple Crumble Cider 330ml Bottle – Zeffer, NZL  - ABV: 5.4%

This delicious cider has been spiced with cinnamon and blackberry leaves to give a mouth-watering drop that is like enjoying a piece of apple crumble with vanilla ice cream. Beautifully balanced with intense depth of flavour.

Red Apple Cider 330ml Bottle – Zeffer, NZL  - ABV: 5.0%

This cider captures the fresh flavour of the unique Mahana Red apples used to make it. Grown in Nelson, these flavourful and aromatic apples result in a juicy full flavoured cider with a lovely, toffee nose and tastes like a crunchy fresh apple.

Lemon Cooler 330ml Bottle – The Arnold Brothers, AUS  - ABV: 8.0%

This refreshing brew is made with a perfectly balanced blend of spritzed Riverland white wine and fresh Riverland lemon juice. It's an Australian hand crafted remake of the ever popular 80's Californian Wine Cooler.

Wallaby Cider 330ml Can – Barossa Valley Brewing, AUS  - ABV: 4.4%

Made with fresh South Aussie apples and Champagne yeast, the addition of cascade hops makes this hoppy cider jump all over your pallet. As refreshing as it is unique, this rarest of wallaby straddles the line of sweet and dry.

Little Pebble - Sauvignon Blanc – Marlborough, NZ – ABV: 12.5%
Passionfruit, blackcurrant leaves and citrus are the defining aromas of this New Zealand wine. Complimented by topical flavours it has a long finish and mouth-watering intensity.

Completely its own! Made from specific parcels of Chardonnay at vineyards across South Australia, this batch was allocated a unique code, separated from other batches and treated independently to ensure cleanliness and purity of winemaking.

Tempus Two - Silver Service - Pinot Gris – NSW –ABV: 12.5%
